For the very first time I started my tour to different parts of Uganda and outside Uganda purposely to see if we can plant new churches in different regions i.e. Northern Uganda, Burundi and Tanzania. I was able to reach towns like Larope, Ajuman, Lira and these areas were badly affected in the bush war.

I talked to some villagers who had just returned back to the land to plant some crops. The farmers who told us that for a long time it has not been raining and indeed the roads were dusty. Their main food crop in this area is cassava and maize.

The following day I was able to visit some churches in Ajumani town, one of the churches I visited was Victory Baptist Church. Attending a church fellowship was very interesting. The Christians played music on local instruments which were self amplified. After the fellowship we were received at one of the senior pastors' home where we were given some food to eat. For the first time we were served with source composed of the type of fish known as Karuka, one of the delicacies in the area. Indeed it was very tasty.

During our stay we went visiting villagers and sharing with them the Word of God. On 22nd I was able to return back to Kampala. One of the needs I found in the area was the need for new churches. I thank God for the church back at home who prayed for my journey.

On 24th July I set off for Tanzania to a place called Shinyanga.

We have seen God manifesting himself mightily not only to the church members, but also the community at large.
